Studio C19 Policy Sept20

- Only 1 student in the studio at any one time
- Please do not attend your drum lesson have, or if you suspect that you may have, Coronavirus C19. See link here for the latest government advice: <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/symptoms-testing/symptoms.html>
- Please do not attend your drum lesson in the studio if you are self-isolating to comply with C19 guidelines.
- Also, to avoid any doubt, I also request that you do not attend a lesson if you are showing any symptoms of a cold or flu.
- I remove the requirement to give 24 hours notice of cancellation, but please give as much prior notice as is possible that you will not be attending your lesson in the studio for the reasons above.
- Please notify me if you have been diagnosed with C19 or that you have been told to self-isolate to comply with C19 guidelines within 2 weeks after your last lesson.

Requirements to bring to every lesson:

- Face mask
- Sticks, brushes etc
- Ear defenders, ear plugs (if you use them)

Entering the Studio

Please:

- Put on your face mask before entering the front door
- Apply the hand sanitiser provided
- Shut the front door
- Enter the studio
- Push the clear plastic curtain to one side and...
- .. take your place seated at the drum kit 😊
- I will shut the studio door
- Please only remove your face mask when we are both seated

Exiting the Studio

At the end of the lesson, please:

- Put on your mask
- Leave via the studio door and the front door.

- Close the front door behind you as you leave 😊

Changing positions in the studio... for me to demonstrate.

- Put on your mask
- Go out of the studio door into the lobby for a moment, whilst I...
- ... take a seat at the drum kit

After my demonstration we do a reverse of the above, always with a screen between us.

Other new measures:

- Feel free to use the hand sanitiser provided at any time when in the studio in studio
- I will provide tissues, but please take any tissues that you use with you when you leave.
- I will leave a 10 min gap between lessons to give me time for sanitising any shared equipment and to avoid students crossing-paths.
- Teaching materials will be displayed on a TV monitor in front of your when sitting at the drums. This is to prevent the use of shared books and sheet music.
- Fans and extractor fans will be circulating a fresh air supply to the studio.
- Screens, fixed and movable, will be in place and used at all times throughout the lesson.

I hope that after your first lesson back in the studio all of this will become natural and will not impair the learning and fun of your drum lesson.
